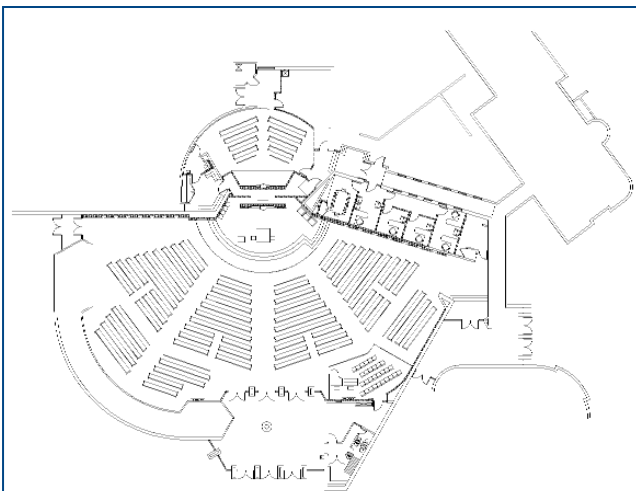
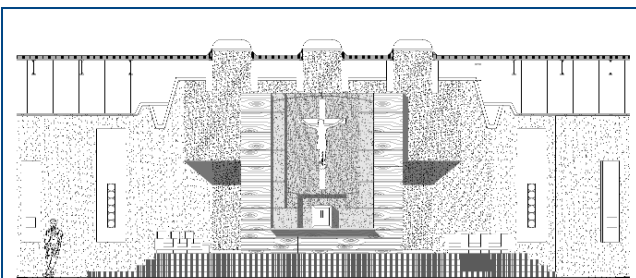

Capital Campaign

My dear Parishioners,

It was four years ago that I answered God's call to return to parish ministry and moved into my current position of pastor at Our Lady of Fatima. It was my belief that I was returning to what I was trained to do; work as a parish priest. I was correct in my expectations. The time has been rewarding and I have witnessed growth in numbers and spirituality at Our Lady of Fatima.

As I look ahead I believe we need to be prepared to accept growth within our community. Thus after a year of reflection, study, prayer and discussion, with the assistance of the Parish Pastoral Council and Parish Finance Committee, the decision has been made to position ourselves to receive that anticipated growth. We will do this by addressing much needed improvements that stretch campus-wide.

Our, "Remembering our roots...building our future" Capital Campaign will be a three-year project designed to raise \$2 million. The repairs will occur in three phases and will not only accent the beauty of our campus but enhance the warmth and friendly atmosphere that has been associated with Our Lady of Fatima for over 45 years. Some of these changes such as the parish center roof and the resurfacing of the parking lot have occurred. Others like the renovation of the sanctuary are scheduled to begin soon.

Besides the repairs, our capital campaign will also function to serve the Little Shepherds of Fatima Fund. Our long-range goal is to use the Fund to provide financial assistance to the school. In the meantime it will, at the very least, lessen the monetary support provided from the parish to the school.

We are entering an exciting time at Our Lady of Fatima. These changes will allow us the opportunity to continue not only our spiritual mission and but to offer a Catholic education for our children. I ask that you join me in praying for the Lord's guidance as we embark upon a new chapter in the history of Our Lady of Fatima.

Project Descriptions

Remembering our roots...building our future

Campus Renovations -

Improvements to the Our Lady of Fatima campus are currently underway and will continue through three phases covering a total of four years. **Phase I** began in January and will run through the fall of 2005 culminating with the dedication of our new sanctuary in September. Some repairs such as concrete replacement and cabinet and door replacement will be ongoing starting in **Phase II**. Others are listed according to the timetable beginning with **Phase I**.

- Parish Center roof replacement.
- Parking lot sealing and striping.
- Sanctuary renovations including; an Adoration Chapel, baptismal font, new sound system, pews, lighting, relocation of the choir and new offices.
- New swamp cooler for the Religious Education building.

Phase II reconstruction begins in April 2006 and will address these items.

- Stair replacement at the church building entrance.
- Concrete repairs.
- Upgrading the main entry, the principal's and upstairs offices at Our Lady of Fatima School.
- Replacing carpet in the Religious Education building.
- Bathroom conversion in the Religious Education building.

Projects in **Phase III** will begin in April 2007 and conclude in June 2009. Earmarked for renovations during this period are the following.

- Continued concrete repairs.
- Millwork replacement such as new doors and cabinets.
- Parking lot lighting.
- Replacement of the carpet in the Parish Center.
- Work to the school's mechanical system for improved ventilation.
- Upgrades to the school's west entrance.
- Enclosing the trash dump.
- Fence and gate replacement.
- Repairing and or replacing the roof of the church building.

Remodeling/Repairs: \$1,000,000



Little Shepherds of Fatima Fund -

The Little Shepherds of Fatima Fund is designed to provide funding to the school so it may continue to offer an education based upon our Catholic ideals. This includes offering tutoring assistance to students of those families in need and providing finances for school repairs. An increase in the Little Shepherds Fund will at the very least, lessen the yearly financial burden placed upon the parish.

Little Shepherds of Fatima Fund: \$1,000,000
